In Santa Barbara County
Federal Fiscal Year 2007**

(October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007)



Annual List of Projects with Federal Funding for Federal Fiscal Year 2007

Federal law requires SBCAG to publish for public review an annual listing of projects for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year, as a record of project delivery and a progress report for public information and disclosure.

This report indicates that approximately \$30 million in federal funds were obligated for 38 transportation projects in the region between October 1, 2006 and September 30, 2007. The federal funding consisted of \$25 million of Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds for road, bicycle/pedestrian facilities, transportation enhancements, and air quality projects and \$5.7 million in Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds for transit projects.

The breakdown of expenditures by project type is as follows:

The most common projects to receive federal obligation in Santa Barbara County for Fiscal Year 2007 include Roadway Operations\Maintenance to repair storm damage and make bridge improvements. Bus transit operations and capital projects are also another type of project that received large amounts of federal funding.
